# FAQ's on the back

**Business Membership:** The annual business membership allows one designated business to have a family membership. The family membership does not have to be the owner of the business. It includes 10 nine hole passes to allow your friends, family, or clients a round of golf on your business. It also includes the opportunity to hang your business sign in the clubhouse for that season. The signs are 8.5x11 and Stateline Designs does a nice job making them for about \$30. The sign is at your expense. The 9-hole passes are handled in the following manner: The person receiving the free pass registers under the deck, or in the clubhouse, they fill out the envelope stating their name and that it is a free pass with the business' name. We will keep track of the passes and notify you if you are running short on them. This is a nice way to show your business' support for the golf course and might help with a deduction on your taxes too. Upon special approval by the GM, businesses may swap the family membership with additional passes in place of it on a case-by-case basis.

**Non-Golfer Business Membership**: It is basically the same as the regular business membership but without the family golf option at a reduced cost.

**<u>Family Membership</u>**: A family membership includes the spouse and the children living with the paying adult. Your children are considered members if living with the paying family < or = 22 years on May 1<sup>st</sup>. A family membership is obtainable if you are not married, however they must be living "under the same roof" and living as a couple.

**Student Membership:** All Students can receive a student membership if they are < or = 22 and a full-time student. They must be enrolled <u>full time</u> in school and < or = 22 years or younger on May 1<sup>st</sup> to qualify. LCC has an agreement with Lemmon Schools that any active member of the golf team has free membership for that child for that golf season and throughout the summer of that particular golf season.

<u>New Single Memberships</u>: New singles memberships are for individuals that have <u>never</u> been a member at any time of LCC in any capacity; which includes, business, family, student, out of town, lapsed, or any other membership.

**New Family Membership:** a new family membership is for a family, where no individual of the family, has ever been a member of LCC at any time, in any capacity; which includes, business, family, student, out of town, lapsed, or any other membership.

### Answers to FAQ

- The clubhouse minimum is required for all members except student memberships. Upon payment for your dues, a \$100 gift card will be issued to you for clubhouse goods. This gift card must be used by the end of the season, or will be forfeited back to the course.
- Green fees paid cannot be used towards an annual membership
- Dues for members, other than new members, are to be paid in full by May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. A late fee will be assessed after this date.
- An installment plan may be obtained of membership dues. These arrangements must be made prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>, or a late charge may be assessed.
- All carts used on the course must pay annual trail fees or pay the single use \$5 trail fees for the cart.
- In order to have a 99-year lease on a cart shed spot, you must have a current annual membership, or you will be required to pay the year-to-year annual fee.
- Any cart space not paid for will be considered forfeited to the course. Violators will have 6 months past the due date to bring their account current before it is considered abandoned. An abandoned cart will become the property of the course. The previous owner may however have to pay any disposal charges, land fill fees, and any other miscellaneous fees incurred to remove and dispose, of the cart or other property left behind.
- Memberships or partial memberships, offered to individuals as payment in kind, services rendered, or an installment plan, etc., must be approved by the GM prior to the occurrence.

5/20 Saturday – (NEW) <u>The TP27</u> Tee off 12:00 Entry \$100/team 2-person teams. Based off of the old 27 holer. Sponsored by Turning Point Christian Center. Added Purse, many additional prizes. More details to follow. Food available before, during, and after.

5/29 Monday - <u>Memorial Day Scramble</u> 18 holes - 1:00 Tee Off - \$25/person. Please register ½ hour prior so that we can get started on time. We will draw for teams prior to Tee Off – No need to have a team lined up ahead of time. Food will be available.

6/10 Saturday – <u>Dacotah Bank Tourney</u> - 2 person pick your own team- **FREE** – 9:00 am Start Nine holes Hettinger – Nine holes ends in Lemmon. Lunch to be provided at the afternoon location. This is a really fun tournament designed for the "higher" handicapped golfer in mind. Scoring is based on a version of the "Old Chicago System" in which you want to card higher numbers. The point system is as follows – Double Bogey or worse 0; Bogey 1; Par 2; Birdie 4; Eagle 8. All golfers must have an established handicap before play. This can be achieved from this order: "league" scores; GHIN card; or we will assign you one before the tournament. All handicaps are not to be greater than 18 based on 9 holes. Here is a couple of examples: Golfer 1 has a 18 handicap; they would start the tourney with 0; so during the 9 holes they card 2 pars, 2 bogeys, and the rest double bogeys or worse; (6 points scored + 0 starting) their score would be a 6. Golfer 2 has a 0 handicap; they start with -18; so if they have 6 pars, 1 bogey, and 2 birdies; (21 points scored -18 starting) their score would be a 3. So as you can see it would be a great tournament to play being a higher handicapped player. Dacotah Bank sponsors this fun tournament with added purse from Dacotah Bank. Supper will be available. Please sign up ahead of time at the clubhouse.

6/16 Friday Evening – <u>Greens Keeper's Revenge</u> – 3-person pick your own team 1 must be a female - 9 holes - 5:30 pm Tee Off SHARP! Sign your team up by calling The Lemmon Chamber Office prior to Friday. A lighthearted tournament with goofy obstacles on every hole. Meal to follow the golfing and is included in your tournament fees (\$100/team)

6/18 Sunday – <u>Big Cup Father's Day Scramble</u> - 1:00 – 18 holes - \$20/person. Please register ½ hour prior so that we can get started on time. We will draw for teams prior to Tee Off – No need to have a team lined up ahead of time. This tournament will feature "BIG CUPS". Putting should be a breeze with the cups twice as big. Food will be available!

6/24 Saturday – <u>Moser Hay Grinding's Scramble</u> –<u>NOTE CHANGES</u> <u>4-person pick your own teams!</u> \$100/team – Florida Scramble Format -Tee Off 1:00 – Please register ½ hour prior so that we can get started on time. - Sponsored by Moser Hay Grinding – \$1,000 Added.

7/7 Friday Evening – <u>3 Club tournament</u> – 2-person pick your own team – \$20/person. Scramble format -9 holes -Must play with at least one other team. Tee Off any time after 2:00 pm (only need to be completed before it's too dark) Each golfer uses only 3 clubs. Both golfers must use the same type of club. - for example: if driver is selected each golfer must select a driver. 3 clubs only; putter is included as a club if chosen. A player can play more than once with another player and can place each time. A player can play more than once with the same player (to improve their score) but can only place once. Unlimited mulligans for purchase! Supper will be available.

7/8 Saturday – <u>Boss Cowman Scrambles</u> –9:00 am morning tournament is separate from afternoon session. The morning session is a pick your own 2 person/ 3 shot scramble \$50 team.
