REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL LEMMON, SOUTH DAKOTA JANUARY 3, 2022

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the Regular Meeting of the City Council of Lemmon, South Dakota was held on Monday, January 3, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

Mayor Neal Pinnow and the following City Council were present: Wayne Corcoran, Pat Dalzell, Cathy Evans, Art Pederson, and Tim Pelkofer. Absent was Matt Barnes. Employees in attendance were: Chad Abel, Annette Dalzell, Dave Huber, Raven Christman, and City Attorney Shane Penfield.

Others in attendance were: Colleen Pederson and LaQuita Shockley

Mayor Pinnow called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Dalzell moved, Corcoran second to approve the Agenda. All voting "Aye"; motion carried.

Corcoran moved, Pederson second to approve the December 6, 2021, Regular Meeting minutes. All voting "Aye"; motion carried.

Dalzell moved, Evans second to approve the December 29, 2021, Special Meeting minutes. All voting "Aye"; motion carried.
